ATHLETE AWARDS STRUCTURE

A new Initiative to recognise the **20th Anniversary Meeting** and the top performers at the **2024 Team Ledger Harcourts Capital Classic** sees a change to the Awards away from the traditional 1st, 2nd and 3rd model for Awards.

The 2024 structure is based on athlete performances. This initiative is designed to recognise the top performers across the disciplines and in particular the events that may have greater depth of elite performers in the same discipline pushing each other to higher performance levels.

The AWARDS will be:

- ❖ **The top twenty [20] Athletes** will earn **Team Ledger Harcourts Capital Classic Awards** to the value of **\$500.00 each** based on World Athletics event performance points.
- ❖ **The twenty [20] Athletes ranked 21st to 40th** will earn **Team Ledger Harcourts Capital Classic Awards** to the value of **\$200.00 each** based on World Athletics event performance points.
- ❖ **Twenty [20] Athletes** will earn **Team Ledger Harcourts Capital Classic Awards** to the value of **\$100.00 each**. These final set of 20 Awards will be allocated as follows,
 - The **top 6** based on **Para Athletes** based on WPA % scores.
 - The **top 7** based on **Under 23 athletes** based on World Athletics event performance points.
 - The **top 7** based on **Under 18 athletes** based on World Athletics event performance points.

❖ **NZ \$ 4,000.00 MEET RECORDS BONUS AWARDS POOL**

This bonus pool is shared with any athletes establishing a NEW Meet record.

i.e. In 2023 4 new Meet records enable 4 athletes to earn \$1000.00 bonus courtesy of Team Ledger Harcourts

- ❖ **All Events and division of events will be Awarded the Team Ledger Harcourts Capital Classic 20th Anniversary medal for podium places.**
- ❖ Athletes will only be able to claim **one Award** that being the Award of highest value.
 - ✓ *The initial Result Score may be altered taking into consideration the following factors:*
 - *Wind reading & Best Legal Jump (BLJ) for Sprint and Horizontal jumps.*
 - *see 2.2.1 of World Athletics Track & Field Ranking method.*
 - ✓ *Results will only be recognised where specified by the Meet Director for Under 20 aged Specifications.*
